### **Limits and Fees**

**The first 50 pounds of HHW accepted for drop-off is at no charge to the resident. Any amount of HHW over 50 pounds can be disposed of at a cost to the resident of \$1.00 per pound.**

**NOTE: Latex paint is not a hazardous material. We're excited to offer latex paint recycling as an alternative to trash disposal. Latex paint can be recycled at a cost of \$0.20 per pound.**

**Due to funding constraints, residents from the City of St. Louis and Jefferson County will be limited to one drop-off per year.**

### Directions

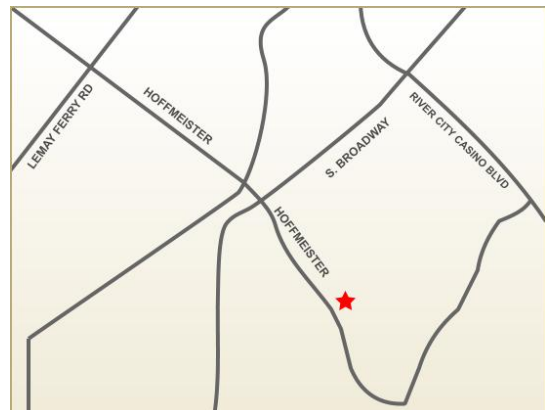
#### From Northbound I-55

Exit at the Carondelet/River City Blvd Exit 202A.  
Right on River City Blvd  
Right on Broadway (Right before Casino entrance)  
Left on Hoffmeister  
We are about 1 block down Hoffmeister on the left.

#### From Southbound I-55

Exit at the Germania Exit 202B  
Left on Germania  
Right on Broadway  
Left on Hoffmeister  
We are about 1 block down Hoffmeister on the left.
